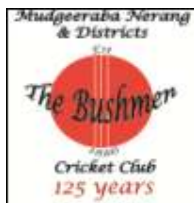

Cam's record is second to none and we look forward to another successful season under his leadership. Training will be tweaked this year, resulting in Thursdays being an “all grades night” finishing at 7.00 p.m. to allow for all players to have a feed and a quiet one while the teams are announced for the coming weekend.

Our juniors are also looking at another huge season. All junior coaches will again have Level 1 coaching credentials (incorporating an umpire's accreditation) paid for by the club and we are looking at updating all team kits including coaching aids and first aid kits. Cam will also be conducting “coach the coaches” clinics to assist junior coaches and managers. The junior teams are very labour intensive, so again if you are able to help, please offer your services. As with previous seasons, we must have parental volunteers for each junior team.

Kev Veivers and his band of merry helpers will again be running arguably the most popular and successful In2 Cricket programs that you could find anywhere. Friday nights will also see Under 10 games played under lights. Take the opportunity to come down to the deck for a quiet refreshment, a magnificent meal from the bistro and enjoy seeing the sport played for all the right reasons by some budding young champions!

There will be a number of social nights planned for the season so keep your eye on the website for details.

The club has to a certain degree become a victim of its own success, as we are now obliged to collect and pay GST. As the former far exceeds the latter, the club has a quarterly GST commitment that it must fund from its operating income. Whilst we are loathe to do so, this has lead us to increase annual fees for all players by \$10.00. We have kept this increase to an absolute minimum and will continue to strive to deliver value for money for all our members.

Pre-season training for senior players commences 31 July 2011 and club sign on is 21 August 2011 – we hope to see you all there!

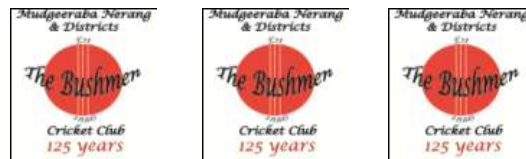

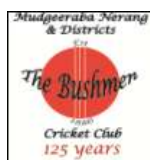

Mudgeeraba Nerang & Districts Junior Provident Fund Program

In Season 2010-2011 MNDCC introduced a new scheme aimed at helping younger cricketers at our club achieve their goals and also reward them for their loyalty to the Bushmen. The details below hopefully explain the system and its workings, but please feel free to contact me personally at the club for more info.

Players who are under 21 and have played at least 1 year of junior cricket at the MNDCC are eligible for participation in the fund. Conditions apply, see below points:

- Upon participation as a team sheet nominated player in 1st grade, \$20 will be deposited into a trust account on the player's behalf per Saturday. In the event of a total washout no money will be deposited for that day.
- Upon participation as a team sheet nominated player in 2nd grade, \$10 will be deposited into a trust account on the player's behalf per Saturday. In the event of a total washout no money will be deposited for that day.
- Any player who has played junior cricket at the MNDCC and decides to play senior cricket at another Cricket Gold Coast club before turning 21 will forego his provident Fund entitlements and the money will be transferred into general revenue for the MNDCC.
- When the player turns 21 he or she will be presented with a cheque from the provident fund to be used in any way the player decides appropriate. During cricket season this will be done with an official presentation at the club.
- In the event that a player who is a member of the fund decides to leave the MNDCC to go to a higher level of cricket ie. the Gold Coast Dolphins, application can be made to the committee to access part of the player's funds to help pay the player's fees at his or her new grade club or indeed for representative fees associated with State or National representation.
- Should a former MNDCC player playing at a grade club ie. the Dolphins turn 21 they will still receive their provident fund monies providing they have not played senior cricket for any other Cricket Gold Coast club at that time.
- Monies will only be deposited into the fund for eligible players taking part in MNDCC fixtured 1st and 2nd grade games including finals.

As a working example a player may make 2nd grade at 17 –

- * Play 12 weeks of cricket - \$120
- * Play 6 weeks at 18 of 2nd grade - \$60
- * play 16 weeks at 18 of 1st grade - \$320
- * Play 24 weeks at 19 of 1st grade - \$480
- * Try out at Dolphins at 20 - \$0
- * Come back to the MNDCC and play 12 weeks 1st grade before turning 21 - \$240

Total from fund to player \$1,220.00

The MNDCC has always fostered the development of juniors playing senior cricket and there are numerous examples of 14 & 15 year olds playing 1st and 2nd grade so there will be varied amounts earned up to the age of 21.

It is always our goal to produce players who can go on to the highest level of cricket their talent and dreams will take them, and hopefully this will help in some small way financially either at 21 or earlier if fees become an issue at grade level.

CODES OF BEHAVIOUR

Players

1. Compete by the rules and in the spirit of the game and never dispute an Umpire's decision by word or gesture.
2. No sledging or swearing.
3. Be a good sport and encourage and support your own team members.
4. Work equally hard for yourself and your team - your team's performance will benefit as will your own.
5. Co-operate with your coach and fellow team members.
6. Show respect for your opponents and their skills and be friendly to all participants.
7. Seek permission before leaving a game.
8. Control your temper.
9. Play for the fun and not just to please parents and coaches.

Parents

1. Encourage your child to always participate according to the rules and spirit of the game.
2. Encourage your child to participate if they are interested and remember children are involved in organised sport for their enjoyment.
3. Remind your child that participation in a team sport involves support and encouragement of the team members with the benefit of developing lasting friendships.
4. Teach your children good sportsmanship by example - applaud good play by team members and opponents alike and congratulate all parties.
5. Don't badger, harass or use sarcasm to motivate your child or compare your child's performance with those of other children.
6. Let the coach do the coaching, and recognise the value and importance of volunteer coaches who deserve your support.
7. Treat your child the same irrespective of their individual performance.
8. Demonstrate appropriate behaviour by not using foul language, harassing players, coaches or officials.



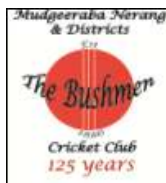
CODES OF BEHAVIOUR

Coaches

1. Be reasonable on your demands on young players' time, energy and enthusiasm.
2. Avoid over playing the talented players. The average players need and deserve equal time.
3. When coaching representative teams, ensure all team members have equal opportunities in front of selectors.
4. Plan coaching sessions that are active and varied and ensure that equipment and facilities are suitable and safe to use.
5. Remember that children participate for fun and that winning is only part of the motivation.
6. Teach your players to play by the rules of the sport, and develop team respect for the ability of opponents and each other.
7. Encourage them to participate in the spirit of the game, to develop a sense of fair play and maintain a positive team spirit.
8. Censure immediately any sledging or swearing.
9. Respect decisions of Umpires.

Cricket Gold Coast have advised that behaviour in cricket is going to be under the microscope this season(in particularly Juniors) name calling and inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated and will be dealt with harshly.

Should any incidents occur at games, please inform your Coach/Captain immediately or alternatively advise either Dave Haupt (Senior Vice President), Paul Gayfer (Junior Vice President) or Graham Shepherd (President) so the matter can be dealt with in a speedy and efficient manner.

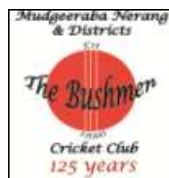

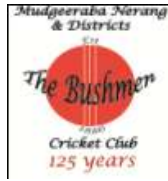
